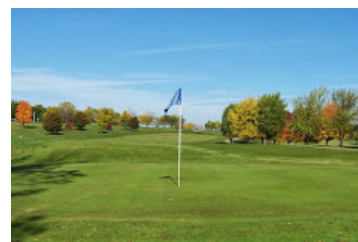

### **Construction Quality Workshop - Spring 2015**

Construction Quality is an issue for Engineers Without Borders chapters. Given limited time for an implementation trip, unforeseen changes often force project teams to improvise construction plans based on the resources available to them. If the members of the team do not have significant Construction Management experience in the discipline of the project, this can often lead to projects of inferior quality that either require extensive maintenance or fail.

To improve the quality of construction done by EWB project teams, a Construction Quality Conference is proposed. The conference will expose participants to examples of high and low quality construction, with a focus on recognizing signs of poor construction, and empower participants to re-evaluate their construction plan if they recognize these signs in their own projects.

The conference would be targeted towards members of the EWB-GL region, particularly students. To encourage
